## About Dermacon 2024 Host City "Hyderabad"

In 1950 the princely state became the state of Hyderabad in the Indian union. In 1956 the state was split up: its Telugu-speaking areas (the Telangana region) were combined with what was then Andhra state to form Andhra Pradesh, with Hyderabad as the capital. Discontent grew, however, among the people of Telangana, who insisted that the region should become a separate state. Following protracted negotiations—particularly about the disposition of Hyderabad—and after receiving approval for the split from the Indian parliament, Telangana was formed in 2014.

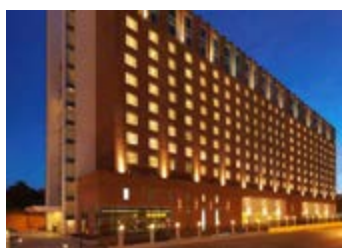

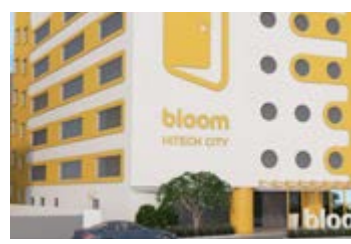

## The Charminar

He believed that all people, regardless of their caste, creed, or gender, were equal in the eyes of God. The statue serves as a reminder of this message and encourages people to work towards building a more just and equitable society.
